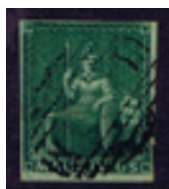

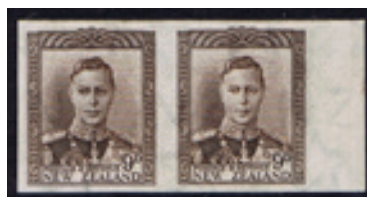

Public Auction 6 sees us change venues from previous Public Auctions. We have taken on an extra half a floor at our Newmarket Offices and as such are now able to use the extra space to hold our Public Auctions 'in house' at 1 Ngaire Avenue Newmarket, Auckland. The office has car parking on site as well as extra parking on the street. We will use our expanded office for viewing and then on Auction Day, the Auction will be held directly next door - a walk which takes less than 30 seconds.

We're delighted to be able to now hold these Auctions in house - the convenience will save time and we expect that clients will find access easier than at the previous venue.

Public Auction 6 will be held at 1pm on Saturday March 22, 2014 at Auckland City Stamps, **1 Ngaire Avenue, Newmarket Auckland**. The Auction comprises 945 lots of Collections, Box Lots, Postcards, as well as a good selection of Stamps & Covers from the World & New Zealand.
