Welcome to Auckland City Stamps Public Auction 24. The auction is again split over two days. We commence with lots 1-381 being Box Lots & Collections at 11.00am on Saturday March 18. At 9.30am on Sunday March 19 we will offer the individual World & New Zealand Stamps & Cover Sections comprising Lots 382-773.

The entire Auction contains 773 lots of Worldwide Stamps, Collections, Box Lots and Postal History with Estimates of over \$440,000. We recommend those who are wanting to view the Box Lots & Collections to make plenty of time as these sections have much to offer.

The Box Lot Section has 186 lots including Lot 1 World Lifetime Collection (Est \$3250), Lot 38 A Large New Zealand Collection in 7 Albums (Est \$6500), Lot 135 French Colonies 2 Volume Collection (Est \$3500) and Lot 167 Pacific Islands Collection (Est \$2000).
