**AUCKLAND CITY STAMPS, 1 NGAIRE AVENUE, NEWMARKET.**

Welcome to Auckland City Stamps Public Auction 26, split over two days with a total 1058 lots and estimates of over \$900,000.

We commence with lots 1 - 329 being Box Lots & Collections at 11.00am on Saturday March 9. At 9.30am on Sunday March 10 we are pleased to offer the **Klaus Moller Gold Medal Winning New Zealand Chalon** (Full Face Queen) Collection comprising lots 330 to 562. The offering of 233 lots includes Rare Perfs, Watermarks, Bisects, Multiples and Postal History. The majority of the stamp lots come with Odenweller Certificates.

**Session 1** commences at 11am on Saturday March 9 where we offer 180 Box Lots. The highlights include Lot 23 Canada (Est \$1500), Lot 82 New Zealand with 7 Albums (Est \$2950), Lot 118 Rhodesia (Est \$1250), Lot 131 World with 9x Albums (Est \$2500) and Lot 160 New Zealand with 18x Stockbooks (Est \$2000).
