Alan very sadly passed away on March 12, just before the catalogue was finalised. Alan's collection is in our opinion one of the most extensive ever formed and includes many rarities that he managed to acquire over his decades of collecting.

The Public Auction with live on line bidding will be held at our offices in Newmarket on Saturday May 18, commencing at 10am.

Alan Craig, the scientist

Dad was born in Timaru in March 1942. He grew up in Waimate, where his passion for stamps began at the age of six. As the oldest son of a doctor, dad was expected to follow in his father's footsteps and so, after finishing high school, he found himself in Dunedin attending Otago Med School.

After two years he realised that being a doctor wasn't his dream and his keen interest in all things "science" led him to the D.S.I.R. in Palmerston North where he worked for 25 years as a research scientist in an electron microscope laboratory. He worked on topics as diverse as the structure and function of legume root nodules and their role in nitrogen fixation in the soil and diversity and form of collagen fibrils in mammalian connective tissues. In his time at the D.S.I.R. he gained a PhD in Biophysics.

At the age of 48, whilst having a midlife crisis, dad abandoned his science career and with the support of mum (who landed at job at the University of Waikato as the Director of Student and Academic Services), he moved to Hamilton to become a Stamp Dealer. He opened a shop in Worley Place, where one of his first customers was Ken McNaught. Dad and Ken hit it off immediately with their sharp scientific minds and love of philately

they spent many long hours "playing stamps" together as our family laughingly called it. Dad traded out of the shop for 20 years until he moved his business home and built a shop on the front lawn.

Dad's love of philately goes hand in hand with his love of science and after he died one of New Zealand's most distinguished philatelists wrote to me saying of him: "I don't know if there is really such a thing as a 'born philatelist', but if there is, he was one, with his eye for detail and his scientific background." I would say this about sums dad up!

Dad had been eagerly looking forward to seeing this catalogue in print which was a result of a 'lifetime' of collecting and philatelic research, but sadly he died before he managed to put pen to paper and write this brief biography. His vast knowledge of New Zealand Revenues as well as many other areas of New Zealand philately, especially what dad always referred to as "back of the book" philately, will be greatly missed (as attested to by the many emails, letters and phone calls I have received since his death on 12 March 2024)... as will my dad.

Alan Craig, the collector

Alan was both a collector and a stamp dealer. But he was always more a collector than a dealer. With his usual good humour he often said to me that he "wasn't much of a dealer", although, as was his way, this underplayed his considerable abilities as a dealer (especially when it came to finding the unusual in a collection he bought).

Alan will be well known to many readers of this catalogue for his interest in the 'back of the book' collecting areas. That is certainly where his collecting strengths lay. He amassed incredibly deep collections in most areas of revenue, railway, cinderella and otherwise 'unusual' stamp material. Each of these collections were marked by a careful and thorough study of the various printings, papers, perforations and watermarks, all mounted and written up on pages in Alan's

own distinctive way. Doing so, he brought his keen scientific and questioning mind to the task at hand. In many instances, the various studies undertaken by Alan either broke ground by establishing and proving varieties not previously recognised or catalogued or showed previous assumptions or conclusions had been either erroneous or inaccurate. He was always perfectly happy to share this knowledge with anyone who expressed an interest. In fact, once he started in on a topic, he could be hard to stop!

It is also worth recording here that Alan's knowledge of NZ philately was in no way limited to the collecting areas covered in this catalogue. He was always quick to identify exactly which paper the KGV postage stamp in front of him had, immediately spot a line perf stamp amongst a pile of otherwise comb perf stamps and notice when a forged postmark or overprint just didn't look right at first glance. His contributions to the work of the RPSNZ expert committee will be sorely missed!

Given his prolific knowledge, it may seem surprising that Alan was not a prolific writer of philatelic articles. He was the first to admit that he only got round to writing a fraction of what he intended to. That said, his contribution to the literature was not insignificant. In the Revenue sphere, he wrote what for many years was the handbook/catalogue of NZ beer duty stamps, he provided important contributions to the listings in the Kiwi Catalogue and Handbook of Revenue & Railway Stamps and he co-wrote (with me) the first comprehensive article on the NZ Law Courts stamps in The New Zealand Stamp Collector - Celebrating 100 Years! His most significant philatelic article was "Christchurch Exhibition One Penny Claret - A Major New Discovery" New Zealand Stamp Collector 75/4 (pages 93-95) because in this article Alan was able to put to rest the long-standing myth that the penny claret stamp had been sold over the post office counter at the exhibition.

This catalogue includes many of Alan's prized possessions and is a fitting record for one of the best minds New Zealand philately has seen.
