Licensee or Licensee of the Producer	4/- per Centum
Producers and Sisters of the Producer, and their Descendants	2/- do.
Brothers and Sisters of the Father or Mother of the Producer, and their Descendants	2/- do.
Brothers and Sisters of a Grandfather or Grandmother of the Producer, and their Descendants	2/- do.
Persons in any other degree of Collateral Consanguinity	2/- do.
Persons being Strangers in Blood to the Producer	4/6 do.

NOTE.—The Husband or Wife of the Producer is not chargeable with Duty, and the Husband or Wife of a Stranger is chargeable with the rate of Consanguinity.

OBSEVE.—The Duty is payable by eight equal half-yearly instalments: the first to be paid twelve months after the licence shall have been granted or renewed, and the seven following instalments at half-yearly intervals of six months each; and if there be any duty to be paid, the instalments shall be paid.
